We cannot accept:

1. **Used beds including frames, mattresses and box springs.**
2. **Sleeper sofas, recliner sofas, futons, waterbeds, bicycles, or used toys.**
3. **Large appliances, including stoves, refrigerators, freezers, washers, and dryers.**
4. **Some Small Household appliances including food processors, toaster ovens, bread machine, juicers and crock pots.**
5. **Used vacuums.**
6. **Clothing items other than adult size winter coats and waterproof mittens/gloves.**
7. **Computers, books**
8. **Strollers and used child car seats**

Please understand:

- **All donations will be inspected prior to being accepted. STVCC staff reserves the right to refuse any donations if they do not meet the specifications or needs of St. Vincent Catholic Charities; this includes items that are dirty, covered in pet hair or in poor condition.**
- All household items can be brought to St. Vincent Catholic Charities during regular business hours of 8:30 am and 4:00 pm or by appointment. Please call (517) 323-4734 ext. 1050 for an appointment.

To donate items, please call (517) 323-4734 ext. 1050 to schedule a pick-up (most clean furniture items without stains or tears) or to verify donation drop-off days and times. Your call will be returned within 1-2 business days.
Or email our facilities staff at donations@stvcc.org Staff will reply to your email within 1-2 business days.

If you cannot wait to schedule a pick-up or drop-off time, or if you have items that we are unable to accept, there are other organizations in Lansing that do accept limited items. Please call them or stop by to find out if they accept the items you wish to donate.
